WMOC 2010 COMPETITION

- Sprint competition: there will be one qualification race for the Sprint. The best 80 runners in each field will qualify for the A-Final, the next 80 for the B-Final and so on.
- Long distance competition: there will be two qualification races for the Long distance. Based on the two qualification races, the best 80 runners in each field will qualify for the A-Final, the next 80 for the B-Final and so on.

All races will be conducted in accordance with IOF competition rules, including winning times.

TERRAIN LONG DISTANCE

The typical «jurassic» terrain is situated between 1,000 and 1,300 meters above sea level and is generally alternating semi-open and pine forest. The forests are characterised – for the most part – by rolling hills, a diffuse track network and partially rocky ground with occasional smaller crevasses and crags. The predominant features are mainly rock and contour. For this reason runnability is relatively restricted in some parts of the forest.

ACCOMMODATION

A wide variety of accommodation (hotels, apartments, cottage, camping, B&B, groups lodgings) will be available in Le Pays de Neuchâtel and surrounding areas.

A camping area for tents, caravans and motor homes will be organised near the Event Centre. Breakfast and evening meals will be available at the Event Centre in La Chaux-de-Fonds. Online bookings from March 2009 through Neuchâtel Tourism http://www.neuchateltourisme.ch/wmoc2010

TRANSPORT

You can access La Chaux-de-Fonds from one of the Swiss international airports: Geneva-Cointrin Airport (1 hr 20), Zurich-Kloten Airport (1 hr 50), Basel-Mulhouse airport (2 hr) or Bern-Bel Airport (1 hr). There are railway stations in Neuchâtel and La Chaux-de-Fonds.

The organisers will arrange bus transport from the Event Centre and from Official parking. Official parking pass will be required to access to parking areas. Due to limited parking areas on competition sites, use of private cars to travel to competitions will be forbidden.

Tour Operator or groups with coaches will have access with a "coach pass" directly to each competition area. For more information about this possibility, please contact the Competition Information.

Parking cards for "Official parkings" can be booked online (40.00 CHF for the whole week).

Each runner will get a free public transport pass in the Canton de Neuchâtel during the week.



CLOTHING

For all races there are no restrictions on the type of clothing to be worn, however in the Long distance races (Qualification and Final), it is advised to wear long trousers. Studded shoes are not advised for either Sprint race. Spiked shoes are not allowed in Switzerland. Dobb spikes are allowed.



CLIMATE

During August in La Chaux-de-Fonds (1,000m above sea level), you can expect temperatures from 10° to 20° Celsius during the day. In the Jura, the climate could be very variable at this time of year.

VISAS

Thanks to a strong collaboration with the Federal Office for Migration, a simplified Visa application procedure will be set-up for all runners requiring a visa for entering Switzerland. The whole procedure will be available on the WMOC 2010 website as of May 2009 under the "Tourism and journey" section.

OPENING CEREMONY

Will take place in La Chaux-de-Fonds, directly after the Sprint Qualification race on Saturday 31st July.

OFFICIAL BANQUET

Will take place on Wednesday 4th August (CHF 100.00). Online booking is possible with the entry form (number of participants limited).

CLOSING CEREMONY

Will take place in Le Cernil, directly after the Long distance final on Friday 6th August.
